### Division of Environmental Health Services/Injury Prevention Program (DEHS/IP)

#### Steps:

- A. Contact DEHS/IP at (928) 283-2844, M-F 8:00 am to 5:00 pm and provide copies of your information (i.e. name, address, child's name, age, and phone #, etc.) to sign up for the class:
- **To Start:** Go to TCRHCC Public Website
    - ✚ CLICK on "Tuba City Regional Health Care Corporation"
    - ✚ CLICK on "Community Services"
    - ✚ CLICK on "Car Seat Clinic"
    - ✚ CLICK on the "**BRAINSHARK**" symbol to the right →
      - Take the pre-test
      - Watch the video, "Simple Steps to Children Passenger Safety"
      - Take the post-test after the video
    - ✚ You will receive a certificate for passing with an **80% or better**, if you don't pass, you will have to retake the class.
    - ✚ The dates for the CAPP classes are below.
  - Print the Car Seat Certificate or take picture with your phone and bring when you come to class.
- B. Bring the following items to the training:

  - ✚ Traffic ticket and Complaint
